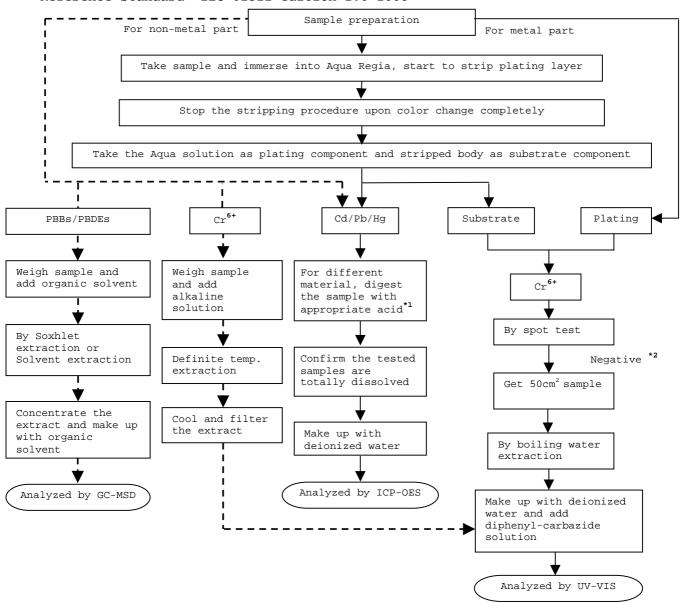

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

Test for Heavy Metal (Sb) Contents Reference Method: USEPA 3052





Test for Halogen Contents Reference Method: EN 14582





Test for Phthalates Contents Reference Method: EN 14372: 2004






